

PRRS-II (with Recommendation)

The Assessment and Scoring

The table labeled “Scoring Table for the PRRS-II (with Recommendation)” shows the complete PRRS-II assessment along with all questions, response choices, points for each response, how the points are weighted, and finally, the contribution that each response to each question makes to the Raw Score. The first question is only relevant to the supervision recommendation.

Using this table, an accurate response to each question is obtained.

- The first question assigns the respondent to one of four categories based on the nature of the current case and their criminal history.
- The responses to the remaining questions have a value associated with each response. Each question requires exactly one response. The value in the Product column for each response is the weighted input to the person’s Raw Score.

After obtaining a response to each question, the Product values that are associated with the respective responses are summed to generate a person’s Raw Score.

Conversion to Risk Level

The table labeled “Raw Score to Decile to Risk Level Table” shows where the Raw Scores fall relative to the Deciles (D1–D10). This table also indicates the correspondence between these scores and risk levels. People with scores of D1–D3 are Low risk, D4–D5 are Medium risk, D6–D7 are Medium High risk, and D8–D10 are High Risk.

Supervision Recommendation

The Supervision Recommendation Matrix is then used to obtain a recommendation level. The Risk levels are shown in the first (left-most) column of the matrix, and the response categories listed in the first question (combination of current offense(s) and prior history) of the Scoring Table are shown across the top row of the matrix. The recommended supervision level is shown in the cell where the person’s risk level and category that question intersect.
