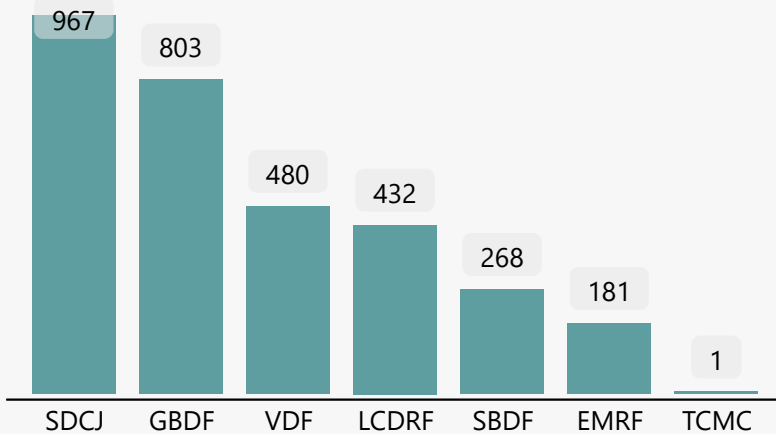

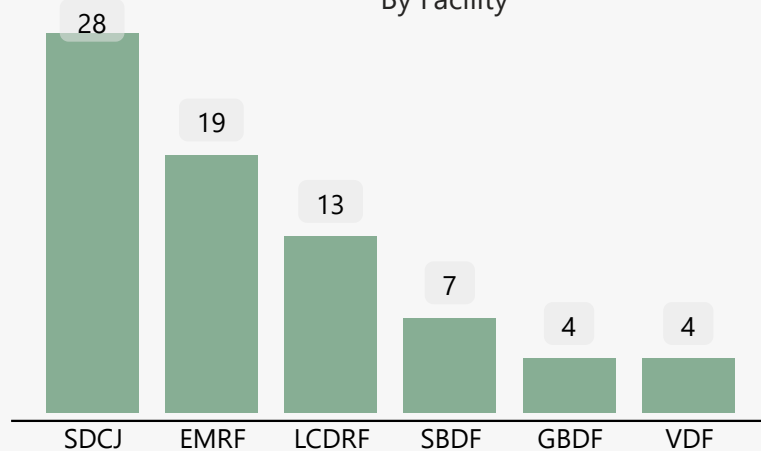

- San Diego County Sheriff's Department; Detention Services Bureau. Data is as of report date/time.
- Totals are subject to change throughout the week due to data reconciliation and updates made to medical directives and patient records.
- Data from all San Diego County detention facilities are included in this report. San Diego Central Jail (SDCJ); George Bailey Detention Facility (GBDF); East Mesa Re-Entry Facility (EMRF); Vista Detention Facility (VDF); Las Colinas Detention and Re-Entry Facility (LCDRF); South Bay Detention Facility (SBDF); & Facility 8 Detention Facility (FAC8).
- The number of individuals vaccinated includes only vaccines administered by San Diego Sheriff medical personnel.
- These counts reflect the first dose administered of the Moderna and Pfizer vaccines and the single-dose shot of the Johnson and Johnson vaccine.
- Vaccinations are tied to the facility where the vaccine was administered and may not represent the housing location where the individual was subsequently housed.
- Timing of the administration of vaccines is directly related to the availability of vaccines which are provided by the San Diego County Department of Public Health.
